The Coopers brewery tour will take you through virtually every step of the production process for both beer and DIY Beer. You will start at our museum, where you'll meet your guide Frank, who is an expert in just about everything Coopers related! After learning about the history of Coopers in the museum, you'll visit our onsite power station on the way to the brewhouse, then check out the bottling hall before heading back to the museum for a beer tasting and a chat with Frank. You'll be able to deck yourselves out in the latest Coopers clothing and merchandise too, which is all on sale.

Proceeds from the brewery tour ticket price go to the Coopers Brewery Foundation, which then distributes all funds to various charities.

THINGS TO NOTE

We have complete wheelchair access but we don't supply wheelchairs. It's not strenuous but you will walk (or wheel) about 1 kilometre all up. It gets pretty warm in the brewhouse – about 5 degrees warmer than anywhere else in the brewery.

Age:	Have to be 18 years or over (hey, it's a brewery)
Cost:	\$27.50 per person inc GST (\$25 is donated to charity)
Duration:	Allow from about an hour and a half up to two hours
Access:	Wheelchairs welcome on every part of the tour
Discounts:	Companion Card holders admitted free (let us know when booking)
Dress:	Remember to wear closed toe shoes

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

If you are using a GPS system to find the brewery, just type in Coopers Brewery or our address.

Next, make sure you're being directed NORTH of the CBD on South Road (sounds confusing, but trust us).

Just to add to the degree of GPS-difficulty, numbers on South Road start at the Torrens River and count both ways.

That's right, there are two 461s on South Road (and the little old lady at the other place is getting really tired of answering the door).

Just copy the link into your computer's or mobile's browser and you'll be sent straight to Google Maps with a marker on the brewery.

From there you should be able to plot your route.

Please be mindful that since the upgrade of the Superway, there is no right turn to Coopers.
